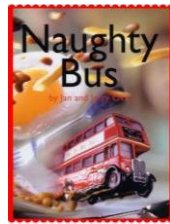
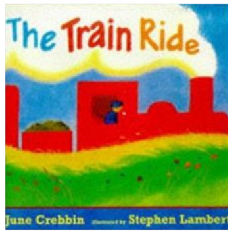




# Nursery News 12<sup>th</sup> January 2018
