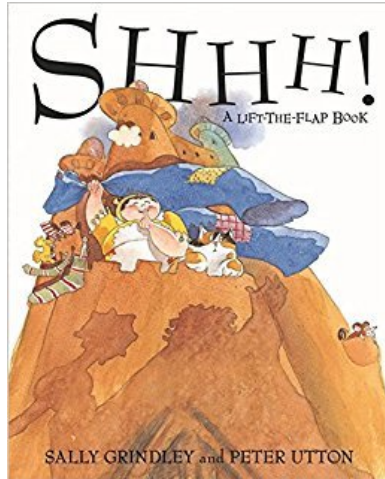


Maths

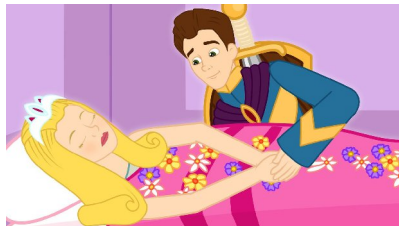
Tapestry
