Attendance reminder

We would like to remind parents and carers that it is their responsibility to update the school **DAILY** on their child or children's absence from school. We would like to make you aware that from 1st September 2017, the criteria for the issue of a FPN (Fixed Penalty Notice) is:

- 10 consecutive sessions (5 days) of unauthorised absence where some or all of the absence may be attributed to an unauthorised holiday in term-time (for absences from 1 September 2017); or
- 15% unauthorised absence (4.5 days) over a period of 6 school weeks for reasons other than unauthorised term time holiday.
