You will know that school has never been closed and that we have had lots of children in every day. However, all children will be back on Monday and it will be great to see them again.


Well done to all our parents and carers for the amazing support you have given your children and the effort that you have put into the remote learning! Thank you so much!

- **Get the school uniform out and ready!** It is a good idea to be totally prepared and to check that everything still fits! Children will still be coming in PE kit if it is a PE day.
- **Order lunch via ParentPay.** Just for these next three weeks we will be offering sandwiches and a hot meal on Fridays. This will change after Easter unless further restrictions are put in place.
- **Bring back any school books.** Make sure your child brings books into class on Monday.
