Science

We will learn about a variety of everyday materials and think about how materials for buildings have changed over time.

We will make our own bricks using a variety of materials and observe changes.

We will identify building materials used in modern houses and houses from 1666.
We will investigate how to change the shape of some solid objects.

We will experience combining rhythm patterns with steady beat, using body percussion and instruments.

We will use a variety of sources to find out about this historic fire. We will look at artefacts related to The Great Fire of London and use our senses to describe what we notice.

We will compare houses and bakeries from the past and present and think about what people have learnt from the Great Fire of London.
