- Role play area- Doctors Surgery, Garage, restaurant, Train station

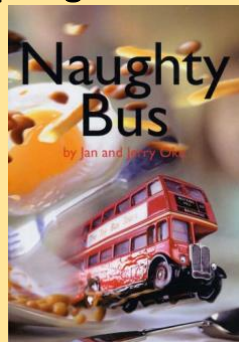
Physical Development

- Introduce hammer and nails to forest school
- Pattern making in gloop, foam, sand. Tyre tracks in paint.

Literacy

- Daily story
- Story box for 'Naughty Bus'
- Individual books
- Home/school Naughty Bus (Bus to travel home)
- Share story box one-one and in KW groups
- Early writing practise (clip boards, lists etc)
- Introduce name cards
