## Assistant Caretaker

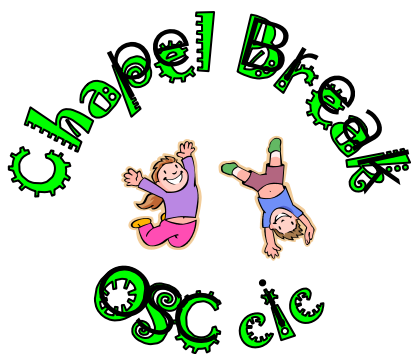
